Roma leather



Roma is a corrected and embossed leather with a soft and waxy touch. A combination of dyes and pigments smooths down some of the structure of the leather. The small grain in Roma may vary in parts and minor colour differences may be visible in the hide.

A thin coat of lacquer gives Roma some protection and simplifies cleaning. Various natural markings will appear in Roma. Throughout an animala lifetime the hide is exposed to both internal and external sources of wear and tear.

The leather may therefore, show various natural markings such as scars, winkles and or abrasions which contibute to the exclusive look of the leather.

It is recommended that furniture upholstered in Roma leather should not be long term exposure to direct sunlight or adjacent to radiators or other source of direct heat. Never use chemicals or synthetic detergents to clean Roma leather.
